Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.129, dated 29.10.2020, registered under Sections 307 read with Section 34 of IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 (Sections 109 and 120-B of IPC added later on), at Police Station Bapoli, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has not been named in the FIR nor any role has been attributed to him.

Learned counsel for the State submits that the petitioner has been implicated on the basis of the disclosure statement made by main accused Raj Kumar. He, on instructions from SI Mahavir Singh, very fairly states that apart from the disclosure statement made by Raj Kumar before the police authorities, there is no other incriminating evidence against the petitioner that links him to the present case, though the

petitioner is already facing trial in two FIRs as detailed in para No.25 of the present petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner responds by saying that in the aforesaid two FIRs, he has already been released on bail.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 04.11.2020 and the trial is going to take long time, this Court finds that the petitioner is held entitled for grant of regular bail. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Nothing observed herein shall be construed to be an expression of an opinion on the merits of the case.
