[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 08.04.2019 in CWP No.9461 of 2019 in case titled as The Janta Co-op. Labour and Construction Society Ltd., Abohar vs. State of Punjab and ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.9461 of 2019 was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 06.02.2019 and take a final decision thereon within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case any amount was found due to the petitioner-Society, to release the same without any delay.

[3] Notice has yet not been issued in the instant case and at the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 06.02.2019 has been decided and payment as per entitlement released to the petitioner, therefore, in the

circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
