The prayer in the present petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus and for appointment of a Warrant Officer to search for the detenue namely, Amandeep Kaur D/o Joginder Singh R/o B-XI-3336, Bajakhana Road, Ward No.18, District Barnala, Punjab.

On 17.01.2022 notice of motion was issued.

In pursuance of the order dated 17.01.2022, the matter has been taken up today.

The learned counsel for respondent Nos.4, 5, 6 and 8 submits that respondent No.4-Samandeep Singh and Amandeep Kaur are in a 'live-in-relationship' and had moved a representation to the police authorities to provide them protection from the petitioner and other

family members. When the protection was not granted, CRWP-609-2022 was filed before this Hon'ble Court and vide order dated 04.02.2022, a Coordinate Bench of this Hon'ble Court had disposed of said writ petition with a direction to the police authorities to look into the representation of the petitioners therein and take appropriate action in accordance with law.

A reply has been filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police (SD), Barnala and the same is taken on record. As per the reply an FIR No.618 dated 28.12.2021 under Section 346 of the IPC, at Police Station City Barnala has been registered against Samandeep Singh against which, a quashing petition has been instituted by him bearing No.CRM-M-3739-2022, which is pending for 29.04.2022.

In view of the aforementioned facts, that respondent No.4- Samandeep Singh and Amandeep Kaur daughter of the petitioner are willingly residing together. No further orders are required to be passed in the present petition.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of in the above-said terms.
