This civil revision is filed to assail the correctness of the interlocutory order passed by the Executing Court on 21.11.2016, while framing the issues in the objection petition filed by the respondents.

This Bench has heard the learned counsels representing the parties at length and with their able assistance perused the paper book.

On the one hand, the learned counsel representing the petitioners submits that the respondents/objectors are the purchasers during the pendency of the suit, hence, their objections are not required to be decided as the third party objections under Order XXI Rule 102 CPC.

On the other hand, the learned counsel representing the respondents-objectors submits that they have already produced their evidence and the witnesses have been cross-examined by the decree holder.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, it would not be appropriate to interfere, at this stage.

However, the Executing Court is requested to conclude the proceedings in the objection petitions, positively within a period of three months, from today.

Disposed of accordingly.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
