The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to official respondents to take appropriate action on the complaint/representation dated 29.12.2021 (Annexure P-6) moved by the petitioners.

It is submitted that respondent No.4 was elected as a Sarpanch of the village Sattowal, Block Rayya, District Amritsar and she, in connivance with respondents No.5 to 12, has destroyed the entire passage to the said village by removing all the bricks, in the name of starting a new development work in spite of loosing the quorum of the village, only to humiliate and harass the petitioners, who are against the unethical behaviour of respondent No.4. Consequently, the petitioners moved a complaint/representation dated 29.12.2021 to respondent No.2-District Development and Panchayat Officer, Amritsar, but till date, no action has been taken on the same.

Now, the prayer on behalf of the petitioners is that a direction be issued to the official respondents to take appropriate action on the complaint/representation of the petitioners in an expeditious manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Tanvir Joshi, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and has no objection if an appropriate direction be issued for deciding the complaint/representation of the petitioners.

In view of the above, the instant criminal writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2–District Development and Panchayat Officer, Amritsar to decide the complaint/representation dated 29.12.2021 (Annexure P-6) within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Registry is directed to send a copy of this order along with copy of the petition and above said representation to respondent No.2-District Development and Panchayat Officer, Amritsar for requisite compliance within the time period granted by this Court.
