The instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.3 to 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the very outset, submits that for their grievance, the petitioners have already submitted a representation dated 13.01.2022 (Annexure P-14) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Landran Road, Sector 76, Punjab i.e. respondent No.2 herein, but no action has been taken thereon so far. The petitioners would be satisfied in case the said representation be decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion only to the official respondents at this stage.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Rashmi Attri, AAG, Punjab, who is present through the medium of video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that the official respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representation of the petitioners.

Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to her during the course of day.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Landran Road, Sector 76, Punjab, to take a decision on the representation dated 13.01.2022 (Annexure P-14) of the petitioners, within a period of one week from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
