AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

Due to COVID-19 situation, the Court is convened through video conference.

This petition under Section 438 read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 36 dated 6.7.2017, under Section 21 of NDPS Act, 1985 and Section 379 IPC, registered at Police Station Kabirpur (Ahalikalan), District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after realising that second petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in a case of bail jump is not maintainable, does not press the present petition. However, a request is made that the petitioner would surrender within a week from today and apply for regular bail. He prays that the petitioner suffered a heart attack, his regular bail application be decided expeditiously.

The petition is disposed of.

Considering the medical condition of the petitioner, in case the petitioner surrenders within a week from today and applies for regular bail, the court concerned shall take up the bail application on the same day and decide it as expeditiously as possible.
