The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.126 dated 30.12.2020 under Sections 406/498-A IPC 1860 registered at Police Station Begowal District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that on account of a marital discord between petitioner No.1 and the complainant, FIR in question was registered against the petitioners. He further submits that pursuant to order dated 14.07.2021, passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel assisted by counsel for the complainant on instructions from ASI Sumandeep Kaur does not dispute the factum of the petitioners having joined the investigation. She, on further instructions states that the petitioners are not required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 14.07.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
