Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that action be taken against private respondents. He further submits that petitioner has filed representation dated 10.10.2021 (Annexure P-2) before the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, for the redressal of his claim and no decision thereon has been taken so far.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, to look into the representation (Annexure P-2) and decide the same in accordance with law within one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
