CRM-10074 of 2022

This is an application for addition of Section 24 of Immigration Act, 1983 in the head note and prayer clause of main petition.

For the reasons stated in the application and after hearing learned counsel for parties, the application is allowed and Section 24 of Immigration Act, 1983 is allowed to be added in the head note and prayer clause of main petition.

CRM-3634 of 2022

Since, the parties are already before the Mediator of Mediation and Conciliation Center of this Court, the application is rendered infructuous.

CRM-M-2345 of 2022

In this petition for anticipatory bail in case of FIR No. 185 dated 27.6.2020, under Sections, 406, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Rupnagar, District Rupnagar, notice of motion was issued and arrest of the petitioner was stayed. The matter was referred for Mediation.

As per report dated 7.3.2022 received from the Mediation Center of this Court, the parties have amicably settled the matter.

In view of above stated fact and the nature of allegations, the petitioner is granted pre-arrest bail subject to joining the investigation within one week. In the event of arrest, he shall be released on bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer. He is directed to join the investigation as and when called for. He shall be bound by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Disposed of.

In case of petitioner not joining the investigation, the State shall be at liberty to move an application for recalling of this order.
