The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for release of the petitioner (detenue) from the illegal detention of respondent No.3 as the detenue has been illegally detained against his wishes by respondent No.3.

The learned State counsel submits that the petitioner was acquitted in FIR No.132 dated 15.06.2018 registered under Sections 420, 465, 466, 467, 468, 471 IPC, 66/66-D of IT Act and 14 of Foreigners Act, at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur, but was admitted to the Transit Camp at Central Amritsar as an internee on 15.02.2020 as the deportation case of the petitioner is still under process and he would be deported to his neighbour country after getting the relevant order from the Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi. Thus, it is clear that it was not a case of illegal detention as the petitioner was detained in the Transit Camp, Amritsar,

which is located inside the Central Jail, Amritsar following due process of law as per the orders of the concerned authority.

In this view of the matter, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.
