AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. Due to COVID-19 situation, the Court is convened through video conference.

This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking regular bail in FIR No. 12, dated 01.12.2021, under Sections 7 and 13 (added later on) of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, registered at Police Station SVB, Karnal (Areas of Jurisdiction Karnal, Panipat, Jind), District State Vigilance Bureau.
