Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.205 dated 25.08.2019 under Sections 279, 337, 338, 427 IPC registered at SAS Nagar (Mohali), and all other consequential proceedings arising out of the said FIR, as the matter stands amicably settled in terms of compromise dated 07.01.2022 (Annexure P-2).

Vide order dated 07.04.2022, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Ilaqa Magistrate within 30 days for getting their statements recorded with regard to the compromise and the learned Magistrate was directed to send a report about the genuineness and veracity of the compromise.

A report dated 15.06.2022 of learned JMIC, Kharar has been received. As per the report, the parties had appeared before learned Magistrate and got recorded their statements regarding compromise. Learned Magistrate has stated that she is of the considered view that the compromise between the parties is valid, genuine, voluntary and without

any coercion or undue influence.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. FIR No.205 dated 25.08.2019 under Sections 279, 337, 338, 427 IPC registered at SAS Nagar (Mohali), along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
