This is a petition that has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.116 dated 24.04.2021 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 342, 379-B and 506 IPC (Section 201 and 326 of the IPC added later on) at Police Station Ram Nagar, District Karnal.

Counsel for the petitioner relies upon an order dated 24.11.2021 whereby co-accused Rahul Puri has been granted concession of regular bail.

Learned counsel for the State is not in a position to controvert the same and admits that the petitioner deserves parity.

Keeping in view the fact that investigation is complete and conclusion of trial is likely to take time, petitioner is granted concession of regular bail subject to furnishing his bail bonds to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
