The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR
No. 173, dated 21.08.2020, registered under Section 452, 323, 148, 149
IPC, at Police Station Khuhi Khera, District Fazilka.

The operative part of the order dated 19.01.2022, vide
which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioners, is
reproduced as under:-

*“...As per the case of the prosecution, the FIR has
been registered on the complaint of Chander Bhan, the
injured. He has stated that after taking meal, he was
resting when Amarjit Singh along with Pasho Bai @
Parkash Kaur and certain other persons entered his house
and caused injuries. As per the case of the prosecution,
Amarjit Singh gave a blow on the left side of his head with
a wooden stick, whereas, Pasho Bai @ Parkash Kaur
started beating his mother when she tried to save the first
informant.*

The learned counsel representing the petitioners contends that there is a delay of 10 days in lodging the FIR and the petitioner No.2 is not named as an accused. He submits that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present FIR.

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 19.01.2022, the petitioners have appeared before the Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Makhan Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioners are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 19.01.2022 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
