Main Petition

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.122 dated 26.12.2020 registered under Sections 306 and 34 IPC at Police Station, Singh Bhagwantpur, District Ropar.

By virtue of the order dated 4.3.2021 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance to the order dated 4.3.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be

made absolute.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.
