Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the present revision petition was directed against order dated 10.05.2017 (Annexure P-1) passed by Court of Civil Judge (Junior Division), Ludhiana, whereby application under Order 23 Rule 1 read with Section 151 CPC was disposed off and the civil suit filed by petitioner No.1 was dismissed, but the liberty sought by him for filing fresh suit was declined.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that during the pendency of revision petition before this Court, the parties have compromised and liberty being sought by the petitioners is no more required.

3. Counsel appears for respondent No.3 does not dispute the aforesaid fact.
