The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 215 dated 02.09.2021, registered under Sections 406 and 420 of the IPC at Police Station Badhra, District Charkhi Dadari.

The operative part of the order dated 24.01.2022, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a Handball coach and is providing coaching in a stadium in village Dohka Moji (Kaluwala) for the last about 10 years and there is no complaint against him.

Learned counsel further submits that petitioner is providing physical training to the students and various aspirants, who are coming to stadium for their physical fitness and the allegation in the FIR that complainant has given Rs. 6 Lakh in cash to petitioner for providing job in Army is an afterthought as the petitioner is not in a position to dominate over any officer in the Army as

procedure for recruitment in the Army is managed by the Army Officers.

It is further submitted that the petitioner has only been providing physical training and he has falsely been implicated in this case.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Deepak Kumar Grewal, DAG, Haryana, who is also appearing through video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and seeks some time to file an affidavit.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 24.01.2022, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 24.01.2022, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
