Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0129 dated 02.11.2021, under Sections 406, 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Phase-11, District SAS Nagar.

Vide order dated 19.01.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Both the petitioner and the complainant are present in person along with their counsel. After interaction with the parties and their counsel, it has been submitted before this Court that in pursuance to order dated 29.07.2022, the parties duly appeared before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and the matter has been finally amicably settled. They however, submitted that as both the parties have agreed with the terms and conditions of agreement and both the parties would abide by the terms and conditions of settlement arrived at between them.

Learned counsel for the petitioner in compliance to the terms and conditions of the agreement, has handed over a demand draft of Rs.5,00,000/- bearing No.965792 dated 02.08.2022 to the counsel for the complainant today in the Court, copy thereof is placed on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 19.01.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such her interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has not opposed the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jasvir Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 19.01.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
