[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 23.09.2019, in CWP No.27184 of 2019 in case titled as '**Vidya Devi** versus **State of Haryana and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP No.27184 of 2019 was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider and decide legal notice dated 16.04.2019 within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order by passing a speaking order after giving opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, failing which, the respondents would be liable to pay costs of Rs.25,000/- to the petitioner.

[3] Learned DAG, Haryana, has produced copy of speaking order dated 06.11.2019 along with copy of the dispatch register, showing the said order to have been dispatched to the petitioner on 06.11.2019. Copy

dispatch of postal article to the petitioner vide No.6383-6387 dated 06.11.2019 is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order dated 06.11.2019 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
