[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 17.09.2019, in CWP No.25846 of 2019 in case titled as '**Subhash Chand and others**versus**State of Haryana and others.**'

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP No.25846 of 2019 was disposed of vide order dated 17.09.2019 by directing respondent No.1 (herein) to decide the claim made in the legal notice served by the petitioners by passing a well reasoned speaking order in the light of orders passed in CWP No.16086 of 2019 dated 19.07.2019 within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] At the outset, learned DAG, Haryana, states that claim of the petitioners as contained in legal notice served by the petitioners was decided by the competent authority i.e. respondent No.1 vide order

Annexure P-1 on 01.10.2019. Order dated 06.11.2019 is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners, who on perusal thereof, states that in view of rejection of the claim of the petitioners, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioners to challenge order dated 06.11.2019 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
