Writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for directing the respondents to grant relaxation to the petitioner regarding Urdu paper in terms of the Punjab Naib Tehsildars Departmental Examination Regulations (First Amendment), 2020 dated 12.01.2021 (P-5).

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioner, states that at this stage, instead of pressing the writ petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case, representation dated 25.11.2021 (P-24) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to that limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Charanpreet Singh, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without adjudicating the controversy on merits, writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.1-Chief Secretary-cum-Financial Commissioner, Revenue, Punjab, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 25.11.2021 (P-24), in accordance with law by passing speaking order, within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
