Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of complaint bearing No. CNR No.PBSAA10022632020 i.e. COMA/84/2020 dated 21.10.2020 titled as “Gaganjot Kaur vs. Sherpartap Singh and others” under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005, Annexure P-1, and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petition has become infructuous as the main case has been withdrawn by the complainant/respondent No.2.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

At this stage, counsel representing the complainant/respondent No.2 submits that a Demand Draft of Rs.35,000/- has been deposited by the petitioners before the Registrar General of this Court in compliance of order dated 15.03.2021, the validity of which has expired. She has requested that the amount be paid to the complainant-respondent as it is meant to enable her to meet the litigation expenses.

The Demand Draft deposited by the petitioners with the Registrar General is ordered to be returned to the petitioners/their counsel with a direction that they will electronically transfer the amount of the Draft to the bank account of the complainant within a period of 04 weeks from today. The details of the bank account shall be supplied by the counsel for the respondent to the counsel opposite.
