The hearing of the case is being held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The petitioner prays for concession of bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.744 dated 25.08.2021, registered under Section 307, 323, 324, 341, 201, 147, 149, 120-B, 34 IPC, 1860, and Section 3 of Scheduled Castes and Schedules Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, at Police Station Sadar Hisar, District Hisar.

As per the case of the prosecution, the first informant alongwith his son and another person were going on a two wheeler and at that time, some one threw a stone, which hit his shoulder. Aman, who was driving the two wheeler increased his speed, however, 8-10 boys came on 3-4 motor cycles and chased them and gave them beatings. Sh. Mahender is stated to have received injury for which the police has registered the case under Section 307 IPC.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that the parties have entered into a settlement. He draws that attention of the Court to an affidavit of Mahender s/o Prem Kumar, the main injured. Sh. Deepak Kumar, Advocate, enters

appearance on behalf of respondent no.2 and 3 and admits the factum of settlement

between the parties.

The petitioner is in custody since 27.10.2021. On conclusion of the investigation, the police has already filed its final report.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and without commenting on the merits of the case, further incarceration of the petitioner is not appropriate. Hence, it is directed that the petitioner shall be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
