Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to decide the representation dated 19.12.2018 (Annexure P-4) and 23.11.2019 (Annexure P-5) moved by the petitioners and release the benefits of promotion, increments and consequential benefits alongwith interest.

At the outset, learned Counsel on instructions from the petitioners submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his clients would be satisfied in case the representation dated 23.11.2019 (P-5) is considered and decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On asking of the Court, Ms.Anju Arora, Addl.AG.Punjab, who is present through Video-Conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioners.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to

respondent No.2-Chairman-cum-Managing Director, Punjab State Power Corporation Limited, Patiala, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 23.11.2019 (P-5) in accordance with law by passing speaking order within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
