Complaining violation of directions issued by the Court in CWP- 23446-2019, titled as “Sunil Kumar Vs. State of Haryana and others”, dated 30.08.2019, the petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. The writ petition was disposed of with the following directions:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner will be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondents to consider the representation dated 04.05.2019 (Annexure P-4) within a stipulated period.

Without going into the merits and demerits of the claim of the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to direct respondents to consider the representation dated 04.05.2019 (Annexure P-4) within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and the concerned respondent shall pass a speaking order thereon, failing which concerned respondent shall be liable to pay costs of Rs.25,000/- to the petitioner. This condition of imposing costs is only to prevent petitioner from running pillar to post and avail remedy of contempt in case of non-compliance of directions issued by this Court.

The writ petition stands disposed of with the above direction.”

In reply, learned counsel for the respondent on instructions from Ms.Preeti, Legal Assistant, submits that in accordance with the directions, a speaking order dated 02.11.2020, has already been passed. However, there is a delay in compliance of the order.

In view thereof, no further order is required to be passed. The costs of Rs.25,000/- shall stand waived.
