1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Learned counsel concedes that no direction was issued to the Assistant Commissioner 1st Grade by the Financial Commissioner (Appeals) vide order dated 01.03.2018, to decide the case afresh within any stipulated period of time, therefore, he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to seek redress of the petitioners' grievance by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
3. Admittedly notice has not yet been issued in this case. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is called for against the respondents. Accordingly, the contempt petition is disposed of as such with the liberty as prayed for.
