The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondent No. 3 to take action against the Investigating Officer, who is not taking any action against accused persons against whom an FIR No. 448 dated 28.9.2009 has registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B and 34 IPC at Police Station Ratia, District Fatehabad.

Reply by way of affidavit has already been filed on behalf of the State, copy whereof has already been handed over to the learned counsel for the petitioner. The relevant para 11 of the same is reproduced hereunder:

“That after going through all the documents and statements of witnesses, the I.O. Submitted his investigation report for cancellation of the aforesaid F.I.R. against the accused with the S.H.O. P.S. Sadar Ratia and on submission of investigation report, the same was deeply verified by S.H.O. P.S. Sadar Ratia as well as by me as D.S.P.(H.Q.), Fatehabad and as

such the aforesaid F.I.R. No.448 dated 28.08.2018, under Sections 420/467/468/471/120-B/34 of IPC has been cancelled, but the submission of cancellation report in the Court is under process.”

In view of the aforesaid fact, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous, however, he prays for grant of liberty to avail of appropriate remedies available to him in accordance with law.

Accordingly, no further order is required to be passed in the matter. As such, the present petition stands disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with liberty aforesaid.
