The learned counsel representing the respondent has pointed out that the present petition has been rendered infructuous as recorded in the order dated 24.07.2017, passed by the Civil Judge (Jr. Division), Bathinda, which reads as under:-

“Applicant Sharda appeared and suffered the statement before this Court that the matter has been compromised with respondent. Written compromise is Ex.CX and Ex.CY. Parties shall be bound by the conditions of compromise. So according to the compromise she does not want to pursue with the case and withdraw the same. Statement of Pawan Kumar also recorded to the effect that he has heard the statement of applicant Sharda which is correct and he agreed with the written compromise Ex.CX and CY and he will be bound by the conditions of compromise. In view of the statements suffered by parties, present suit stands dismissed as withdrawn. File be consigned to the record room.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the revision petition is dismissed as infructuous.
