Prayer is for quashing of order dated 28.10.2021 (Annexure P-9) passed by learned Judge, Special Court, Tarn Taran in FIR No.13 dated 29.1.2019 registered under Sections 21, 29 of NDPS Act at Police Station Sirhali, District Tarn Taran wherein she got absented on 28.10.2021 and consequently, her bail bonds were cancelled and her non-bailable warrants were issued.

Counsel for the petitioner contended that the absence of the petitioner in the trial Court on 28.10.2021 was not intentional and she is ready to appear in the trial Court on the next date of hearing in case some protection is provided to the petitioner by this Court against her arrest.

The fact that the petitioner absented only on one date during the trial has not been refuted by the Counsel for the State.

In view of the above, the present petition is hereby disposed of and the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court on or before the next date fixed there and on her appearance, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail by the said Court to its own satisfaction on furnishing of fresh bail bonds and subject to deposit of ₹ 3,000/- in the fund of District Legal Services Authority, Tarn Taran which will be considered as a condition precedent for accepting fresh bail bonds.
