Writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for directing the respondent-department to remove anomaly of pay between the senior and junior government employees.

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioners, submits that instead of pressing the writ petition on merits, his clients would be satisfied at this stage, in case, legal notice dated 19.10.2021 (P-9) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to that limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioners.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without adjudicating the controversy on merits, writ petition is disposed off with

direction to respondent No.2-Director Public Instructions (Secondary Education), Punjab, to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice dated 19.10.2021 (P-9), in accordance with law by passing speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
