Challenge in the present revision is to the order dated 01.12.2021 passed by the learned Principal District Judge, Family Court, Bathinda, awarding an interim maintenance to the tune of Rs. 10,000/- per month along with litigation expenses of Rs. 10,000/-.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the marriage of the petitioner with respondent was solemnised in the year 1985 and out of the said wedlock, two children i.e. one son and one daughter were born, at present both are married and aged about 32 years and 30 years, respectively. It was the respondent, who herself left her matrimonial house and started living with her parents.

He further submits that the petitioner himself is fully dependent upon his son for his daily needs and the interim maintenance of Rs. 10,000/- per month is on the higher side, therefore, he prays to set aside the aforesaid order.

I have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and have also gone through the paper-book.

Since the petitioner is owner of 10 acres of land at village Tanda Wala and having an annual income of Rs. 4 lakh, no case is made out to grant any relief to the petitioner as prayed for.

Dismissed.
