[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 06.10.2021 in CWP No.20428 of 2021.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 dated 06.10.2021 reveals that CWP No.20428 of 2021 was disposed of by directing the competent authority to decide legal notice dated 31.08.2021 filed by the petitioner by passing a speaking order within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case, the petitioner was found entitled to any amount, to release the same to the petitioner within six weeks thereafter.

[3] None is present on behalf of the petitioner.

[4] Learned AAG has filed reply along with speaking order, Annexure R/1 dated 17.03.2022 accepting the claim of the petitioner and releasing online payment vide receipt, Annexure R/2 on 28.02.2022.

Reply is taken on record. Copy in respect thereof is stated to have already been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.Learned AAG

states that in view of the needful having been done and payment as per entitlement made to the petitioner, nothing survives in the instant petition and the same may be disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971,

[5] I have considered the submission of learned AAG as well as the pleadings and in view of the position noted above, am of the considered view that the instant petition can be disposed of as not calling for any action against respondent No.1 under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. Accordingly, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against respondent No.1 under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the instant petition, in case cause survives.
