Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 78 dated 18.04.2016, under Sections 452, 323, 506, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 17.01.2020, parties were directed to appear before the concerned Appellate Court, Sangrur for getting their statements recorded and the Appellate Court was to send its report regarding the genuineness of the compromise.

A report dated 05.03.2020 of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur has been received. As per the report, the parties had appeared before learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur. Learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur has stated that the compromise has been

effected between the parties is genuine, voluntary and without any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. FIR No. 78 dated 18.04.2016, under Sections 452, 323, 506, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
