The plaintiff has assailed the concurrent orders passed by the trial Court as well as the Appellate Court while dismissing the application under order 39 Rule 1 & 2 CPC for grant of temporary injunction. While issuing notice of motion on 25.04.2016, the Court did not grant any interim protection to the petitioner. The civil suit was filed on 26.05.2015.

The learned counsel representing the petitioner fairly admits that despite his best efforts, he could not contact the petitioner. He expresses his inability to disclose the current status of the suit. However, he submits that the even if the suit has not been decided, the same must be near its conclusion. Even the learned counsel representing the respondent has no intimation.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, it is considered appropriate to dispose of the revision petition while requesting the trial Court to dispose of the suit within a period of 3 months, from today, if not already decided.

Needless to observe that any construction raised by the defendants shall be subject to the result of the suit.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
