Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.32 dated 19.05.2021, under Sections 406, 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Singh Bhagwantpur, District Rupnagar.

Vide order dated 21.01.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 21.01.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 21.01.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
