The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.353 dated 24.10.2020 registered under Section 498-A IPC at Police Station Sohana, District SAS Nagar.

By virtue of the order dated 20.1.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated. He submits that the matter was referred to the Mediation Centre and they have amicably settled the dispute, thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Report of Mediator dated 12.5.2022 has also been received affirming the fact that the matter has been finally settled.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Balveer Singh, has submitted the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 20.1.2022 is made absolute

subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
and the petition stands allowed.
