The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 525 dated 19.08.2019 registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B and 506 IPC, at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat.

Status report by way of affidavit dated 10.05.2022 of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Samalkha, District Panipat, submitted by the learned State counsel in the Court, is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been compromised between the parties on 30.03.2022, copy of which is at Annexure P-8; that the complainant has been compensated to the tune of Rs. 4 lakh by the petitioner; that the material witnesses have resiled and that the petitioner has been in custody since 05.11.2021.

Learned State counsel, opposes the prayer for bail. However, he does not dispute the custody period of the petitioner and the facts that the matter has been compromised between the parties and three material witnesses have resiled.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the paper-book.

The petitioner has been in custody since 05.11.2021. The matter has been compromised between the parties. The complainant has been compensated by the petitioner to the tune of Rs. 4 lakh. Moreover, three material witnesses have resiled. Hence, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
