Case has been heard through video conferencing on account of Covid-19 Pandemic.

It has been stated in the petition that first husband of petitioner No.1 has died and copy of his death certificate is Annexure P-3. It is also the case of the petitioners that they got married on 17.1.2022 against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 12 who are related to petitioner No.1.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that aforesaid private respondents No.4 to 12 have threatened to cause harm to both the petitioners and in this regard, representation dated 17.1.2022 (Annexure P-6) was given to Superintendent of Police, Jind but till date no action has been taken by the concerned authority in this regard.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Naveen Kumar Sheoran, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of State of Haryana. He submits that the concerned authority will look into the matter and take decision on the representation of the petitioners in accordance with law.

In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Superintendent of Police, Jind to consider representation dated 17.1.2022 (Annexure P-6) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law.

However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the marriage of the petitioners.
