1. On 04.02.2022, this Court observed that the instant petition was apparently barred by limitation in view of Section 20 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, whereupon the matter was adjourned to enable learned counsel for the petitioner to address arguments.

2. Today, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has instituted execution proceedings in respect of order Annexure P/1 dated 22.08.2008, therefore, the petitioner may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to pursue the execution proceedings in accordance with law.

3. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner to pursue execution proceedings, in accordance with law.
