This petition has been filed under the provisions of Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C., for releasing the petitioner on parole for 10-15 days, due to the reason that the first birthday of his grand daughter is going to be celebrated on 19 January, 2022 (today).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner's grand daughter's first birthday being today, he may be granted parole, he already having undergone 08 months of actual sentence out of the 02 year sentence imposed upon him after his conviction for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 304-A, 279 and 427 of the IPC. He further submits that this petition was actually filed after his application seeking suspension of sentence could not be heard due to paucity of time on 10.01.2022.

With the date of the petitioner's grand daughter's birthday stated to be today itself, of course that reason for granting him parole stands exhausted and therefore, this petition has been rendered infructuous and is consequently dismissed.

However, looking at the fact that the petitioner is stated to have undergone 08 months out of the 02 year sentence imposed upon him (subject to verification by the learned State counsel), it is directed that his case for interim suspension of sentence can be considered in the application that he has filed, bearing **CRM No.14832 of 2020 in CRR No.980 of 2020**.

Consequently, that application be listed now for hearing on 31.01.2022, with the date of hearing in that case being advanced from 04.05.2022.
