At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner points out that the petitioner has also filed CRWP No.2185 of 2020, also apprehending a threat to his life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.5 to 10, with that petition having been listed before the coordinate Bench.

That being so, just because the petitioner has made another representation on allegedly receiving fresh threats from the said respondents, I do not see how a fresh petition on the same cause of action would lie, when the petitioner can bring that fact to the notice of the court (for consideration on merits), in that petition (CRWP No.2185 of 2020) itself.

Consequently, this petition is dismissed with the petitioner obviously at liberty to file an appropriate application in CRWP No.2185 of 2020 in the context of the allegedly fresh threats received.
