**HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J.(Oral)**

The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer that respondents No.2 and 3 may kindly be directed to take immediate action on the complaint/representation dated 11.1.2022 (Annexure P-3) and pass appropriate order.

Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that as the petitioners were having threat to their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents, the petitioners had filed CRM-M-49440 of 2021, which was disposed of by this Court on 09.12.2021 with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, to look into the representation filed

by the petitioners raising the said grievance and pass appropriate orders within a period of three weeks but even after the disposal of the said petition, again the petitioners were threatened, which fact was brought to the notice of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala vide Annexure P-3 but no action is being taken on the said representation.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, DAG, Punjab accepts notice.

Learned State counsel submits that eight weeks' time was given by this Court while disposing of CRM-M-49440 of 2021, which time period is yet to elapse and while passing the appropriate order, keeping in view the direction given by this Court, even the representation (Annexure P-3) will be taken into consideration by the authorities concerned.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the said undertaking given by learned State counsel, no further grievance of the petitioners survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further at this stage.

Ordered accordingly.
