Writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for directing the respondent to consider and appoint the petitioner against the post of Ward Attendant in pursuance of advertisement dated 04.08.2020 (P-1).

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioner submits that instead of pressing the writ petition on merits, his client would be satisfied at this stage, in case, legal notice dated 06.01.2022 (P-5) is decided expeditiously.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without

adjudicating the controversy on merits, writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2-Director, Department of Health and Family Welfare, Punjab, to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice dated 06.01.2022 (P-5), in accordance with law by passing speaking order, within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order positively.
