Case taken up through video conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner, who is working as a Salesman with the Markfed at a salary of ₹26,000/- has been fastened with a liability of ₹1,05,73,798/- on account of shortage in the stock by the order dated 07.02.2018. The appeal of the petitioner was dismissed on 11.07.2018. He had preferred revision there against in the year 2018 itself which has not been decided till date. He submits that the in a similar petition bearing CWP-26467-2019 titled as **Kulwinder Singh vs. Board of Directors, The Punjab State Cooperative Supply & Marketing Federation Ltd. and others**, wherein the petitioner was also a Salesman with the Markfed and recovery of ₹1,55,29,777/- have been directed against him and the revision petition was pending adjudication, the Coordinate Bench had directed the revisional authority to decide the petition within a period of three months. The Coordinate Bench had also directed that further recovery also be stayed subject to the final order that may be passed by the revisional authority.

He also contends that the remedy of revision petition has been provided in amended Rule 14 D of the Punjab State Cooperative Supply & Marketing Federation Employees (Punishment & Appeal) Rules, 1990.

In view of the limited prayer of the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of without issuing notice to the respondents with a direction to the revisional authority (respondent No.1) to consider and decide the revision petition (Annexure P-4) in accordance with law within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

Further recovery from the petitioner shall remain stayed and would be subject to the final order that may be passed by the revisional authority.
