The prayer in the present petition is for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.1 and 3 not to harass the petitioner and protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and to restrain the private respondent Nos.4 to 10 from interfering in the peaceful life of the petitioner. A further prayer has been made to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to ensure the security of the life and liberty of the petitioner, which is in danger at the hands of private respondents.

Reply dated 07.02.2022 has been filed by Shri Balbir Singh, P.P.S. Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Attari, Amritsar (Rural), as per which the statement of the petitioner has been recorded, wherein she has stated that wherever she is residing, she is residing happily and she does not need any protection. The statement of Baldev Singh, the father of the petitioner has been attached as Annexure R-2/T, in which he has stated that he is the father of the petitioner and she can take every decision of her life and they have no objection to that. He

has further stated that he has not caused any harassment or given any threat to her. The joint statement of as many as eight persons has been recorded which is annexed as Annexure R-3/T, as per which they have stated that they have never interfered in the personal life of Prabhjot Kaur (petitioner) daughter of Baldev Singh and would not do so in the future. She was free to reside anywhere and solemnize marriage with whomsoever she wants to, according to her wishes.

In this view of the matter, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.
