Petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in complaint bearing No.COMI-198 of 2019 dated 15.07.2019, under Sections 354, 323 and 506 of IPC and Sections 3 and 4 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 whereby the petitioners alongwith other co-accused have been summoned to face the trial.

By virtue of order dated 24.01.2022, the petitioners were directed to be released on interim bail on their appearance before the trial Court. As they are continuously appearing before the trial Court, so the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same.

In view of the above, the order dated 24.01.2022 is made absolute. The petitioners will keep continuously appearing before the trial Court during the trial.
