Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0728 dated 01.11.2021 registered for offences under Sections 323, 354, 406, 498-A, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Chandnibagh, Panipat, District Panipat (Annexure P-1).

Counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner, who is the husband of the complainant-respondent No.2, has joined the investigation pursuant to order dated 13.07.2022 passed by this Court. He submits that

matrimonial dispute has been amicably settled and a petition seeking divorce by mutual consent has been instituted where first motion has been recorded.

Upon instructions, State counsel has confirmed that petitioner has joined the investigation. She submits that the petitioner has cooperated with the investigation.

Counsel for the complainant-respondent No.2 has admitted the factum of compromise.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. Order dated 13.07.2022 is made absolute, subject to the fulfilment of conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
