[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of orders, Annexure P/1 dated 21.11.2018 in CWP No.24988 of 2018 in case titled as Radhika Devi vs. State of Haryana and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order Annexure P/1 dated 21.11.2018 reveals that CWP No.24988 of 2018 was disposed of by directing the respondent to pass appropriate orders keeping in view the judgment passed in CWP No.2009 of 2016 in case titled as Balwinder Singh Ors. vs. State of Haryana and Ors. decided on 04.10.2018 within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order failing which Rs.50,000/- would be paid as costs to the petitioner.

[3] At the outset learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of speaking order Annexure R/1 dated 27.08.2020 rejecting the claim of the petitioner while making payment of costs of Rs.50,000/- vide Annexure R/2, the petitioner does not press the instant petition but prays for liberty to challenge order Annexure R/1 dated 27.08.2020 in accordance with law since the same has been supplied to him today.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
