Writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for quashing the instructions dated 17.07.2020 (P-3); notification dated 21.10.2020 (P-5); and appointment letter dated 25.02.2021 (P-6) as well as all similar/identical appointment letters issued to the respective petitioners herein to the extent they have been granted pay scale of ₹35,400/- as per the Central Pay Scales instead of the Punjab Pay Scales.

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioners, submits that instead of pressing the writ petition on merits at this stage, his clients would be satisfied in case, representation dated 09.12.2021 (P-15) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to that limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Charanpreet Singh, AAG,

Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Learned State counsel

raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioners.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without adjudicating the controversy on merits, writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2-Principal Secretary, Department of Finance, Punjab, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 09.12.2021 (P-15), in accordance with law by passing speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
